

# **FUNCTION OF A PORT COMMISSION**

THE BASIC FUNCTION OF A PORT COMMISSIONER is to work as a team with fellow commissioners to plan the port's future, then guide the port's activities in that direction.



## **FUNCTION** OF A PORT COMMISSIONER

- ▶ IN ORDER TO ACCOMPLISH THIS, the port needs a plan. This should contain goals and objectives.
- FROM THERE, you need a strategy or policy for getting to those goals.








## **GETTING INVOLVED**

- THE DAY-TO-DAY
  management of the port is
  the director's job. Let him/her
  supervise staff to function in
  their areas of authority.





## **PARALLEL** LEADERSHIP

THE LATE TOM DOWD, mentor to many port leaders, developed a presentation called "Parallel Leadership."

#### **PORT COMMISSION**

- Monitors Progress
- Contracts with Personnel, Tenants
- Hires the Director and Auditors
- Reviews and Approves the Budget
- Represents the Public Interest

#### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**

- Reports Progress
- Supervises Hiring Process, Practices, Contractors
- Hires, Supervises and Evaluates Staff
- Formulates and Recommends the Budget
- Acts in the Public Interest
