Definition

RCW 39.10.210 provides the following definition:

 Design-build procedure means a contract between a public body and another party in which the party agrees to both design and build the facility, portion of the facility, or other item specified in the contract.





New Legislation

Substitute House Bill 1295 Sections 4-6 made changes to RCW 39.10.300 through 39.10.330:

- Clarifies progressive design-build is included in statute
- Removes limits on D/B use for projects between \$2 and \$10 million
- Contract documents require D/B submit plans for inclusion of underutilized firms





New Legislation (cont'd)

- Inclusion plans to include OMWBE certified businesses, veteran certified businesses, and small businesses
- RFQ document requirements updated to align with progressive D/B process
- Evaluation factors revised to add proposer's past performance in utilization of OMWBE certified businesses





New Legislation (cont'd)

- Evaluation factors updated to include price-related factors (progressive D/B)
- RFP documents updated to better align with use of progressive design build process
- Finalist evaluation factors revised to remove ability for owners to select solely on lowest price





New Legislation (cont'd)

- Contractor now required to track and report utilization of OMWBE certified businesses
- Honorarium payment language revised to require public body to "recognize" level of effort required to meet selection criteria
