

## Job Order Contracting

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#### Definition

RCW 39.10.210 provides the following definition:

 Job order contract means a contract in which the contractor agrees to a fixed period, indefinite quantity delivery order contract which provides for the use of negotiated, definitive work orders for public works





# New Legislation

Substitute House Bill 1295 Section 7 made changes to RCW 39.10.420 through 39.10.450:

- Job order contracting may now be used by all public bodies in the State of Washington
- Unused annual work order limit rolled over to next year (2 year max)
- Maximum work order raised to \$500K





#### Authorized Use

RCW 39.10.420 defines owners justification to use JOC

- Public bodies may use JOC for public works when a determination is made that the use will benefit the public by:
- Reducing total lead-time and cost for construction
- Eliminating time-consuming, costly aspects of traditional PW process





### JOC Selection

- JOC contracts shall be awarded through competitive process
- Published Request for Proposals to include
  - Detailed description of scope & reasons for using JOC
  - Description of required proposer qualifications
  - Identity of specific unit price book to be used
  - Minimum contracted amount to JOC





## JOC Selection (cont'd)

- Protest procedures
- Evaluation process and scoring factors
- Form of Contract to be awarded
- Method for pricing renewals or extensions to JOC
- Proposals are open public records
- Other information relevant to project
- Evaluation committee to select most qualified finalists





### JOC Award

- Selected finalists shall submit final proposals and sealed bids based on unit price book
- Bids may be in the form of a coefficient (+ or -) from the listed price book costs
- Owner shall award contract to highest scored final proposal
- Owner administers protest procedure





### JOC Contracts

- Maximum dollar amount under JOC is \$4 million per year
- Unused capacity of previous year may be carried over to the following year
- Maximum annual capacity shall not exceed 2 year limit
- Maximum total dollar limits exclude sales and use tax
- Length of contract is 2 years with 1 year extension





## JOC Contracts (cont'd)

- Owner may only have 3 JOC contracts in effect at one time
- At least 90% of work must be subcontracted
- Distribute subcontracts equitably including certified minority and women owned subcontractors
- Must pay prevailing wages in effect at the time of work performance





## JOC Contracts (cont'd)

- Maximum work order is \$500K excluding sales and use tax
- New stand alone permanent structure limited to 3,000 gsf
- Any work order over \$350K including over 600 single trade hours shall utilize apprenticeship program
- Owner may adjust apprenticeship requirements with justification





#### JOC Considerations

- When exact scope of work is not defined and cost can be negotiated
- Owner not required to establish unit pricing at the time of selection
- Strict limits on new building construction
- Not necessarily the lowest construction cost
- Subcontractors not required to be selected on lowest price
