







2017: A PLACE TO START - CMA CGM Group aimed at improving air quality globally in our communities, and driving the energy transition to decarbonization

CMA CGM is the first to use LNG propulsion on its ultra large containerships

32 LNG-powered vessels by the end of 2022

44 LNG-powered vessels by the end of 2024

81 LNG-powered vessels by the end of 2026

24 methanol-powered vessels for delivery in 2025-2027

Strategic partnership with WOODS HOLE



Since 2022, CMA CGM has been partnering with the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution (WHOI) to install two acoustic buoys to detect right whales on the east coast of the United States, as part of the Group's commitment to avoid collision with cetaceans

Plastic Ban



Since June 2022, CMA CGM has banned the transport of plastic waste onboard its vessels in order to fight against illegal recycling

New strategic partnership with ONF



CMA CGM expands its support to the French National Forest Office to restore forests burned by wildfires in France
