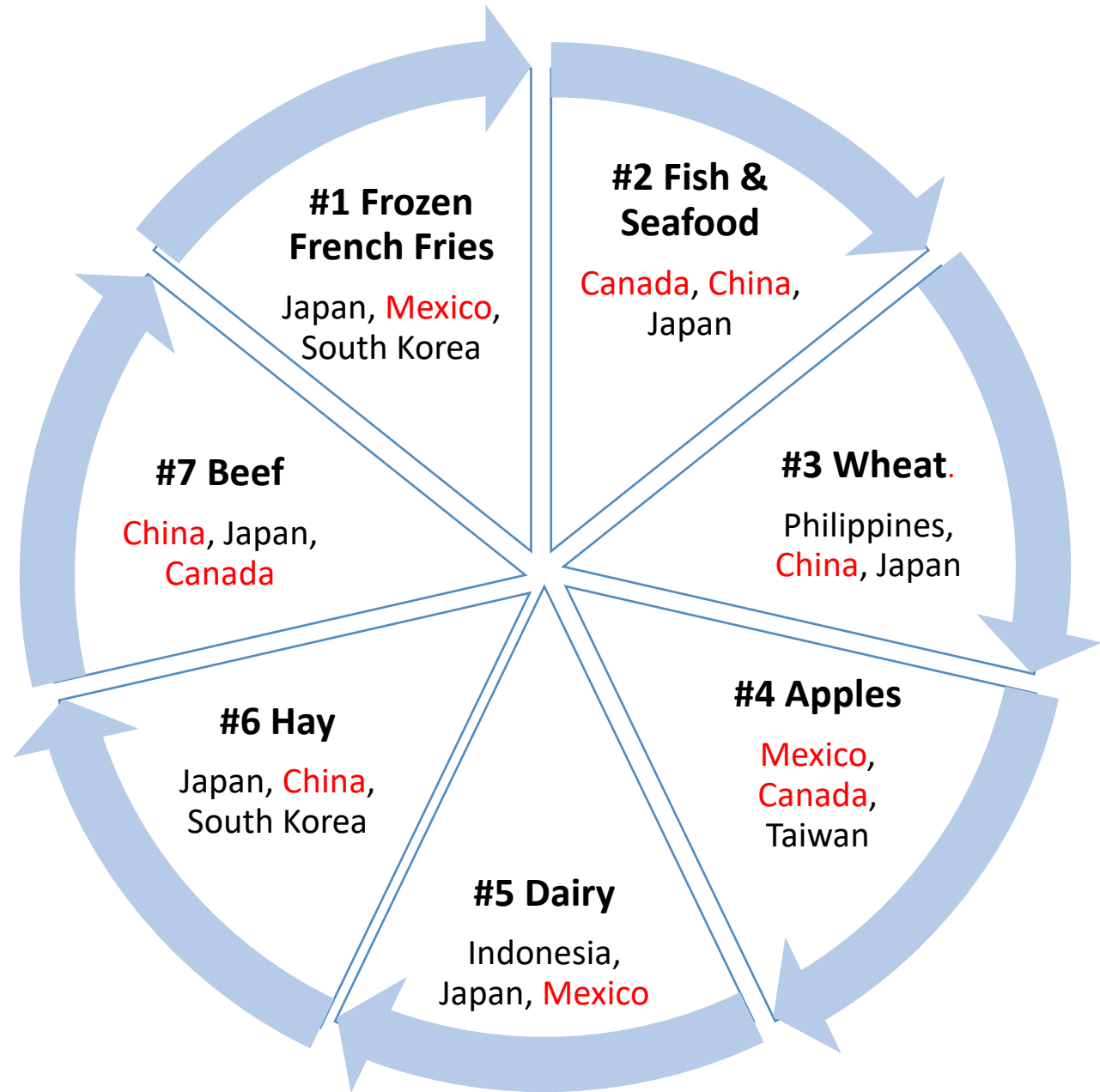

Snapshot of Impact:

2023 Washington AG Exports = \$22B

Products that are especially reliant on global trade include wheat, potatoes and tree fruit

Pass-Through Exports: A significant volume of food and agriculture products from other states including soybeans, soybean meal, wheat and corn are exported through WA Ports every year

Prioritized investments in supply chain infrastructure
