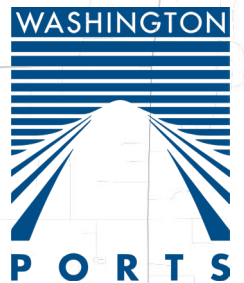

- Satsop's Business Park sits on the grounds of an intriguing, unfinished nuclear power plant, drawing significant public curiosity
- Although tours were halted during the pandemic, the reopening of the port presented an opportunity to enrich the community and visitors alike with a lasting educational asset. Leveraging a Lodging Tax Grant from Grays Harbor County, the port embarked on a journey to chronicle the history of the dormant power plant
- Partnering with a local media company, the port crafted a compelling five-video series delving into the captivating story of the business park and its nuclear counterpart. This initiative has vastly expanded the port's capacity to educate, maintaining a comprehensive library of historical insights readily accessible to the public on demand

PORT OF CAMAS– WASHOUGAL COMMUNITY SOLAR EAST PROJECT

- In 2021, the port spearheaded the development of a comprehensive decarbonization guidebook, laying out a strategic roadmap for sustainable practices. Through this initiative, the port identified 350,000 square feet of rooftop space across its facilities as prime real estate for solar energy installations
- Harnessing its robust network of community partnerships, the port joined forces with Clark Public Utilities to engage public sector stakeholders, local community groups, and individual members. Together, they embarked on the groundbreaking Community Solar East project in 2023 and had a ribbon cutting ceremony on March 27, 2024 which provides 799kW of renewable solar power

CHELAN DOUGLAS REGIONAL PORT AUTHORITY MICROSOFT DATA CENTERS PROJECT

- Chelan Douglas Regional Port Authority embarked on a groundbreaking partnership with Microsoft, resulting in a \$6 billion influx of investment across multiple facilities within its port district
- This collaboration is expected to generate over 900 family-sustaining jobs, marking a significant milestone as the largest private investment endeavor in the region's history

PORT OF VANCOUVER TERMINAL 1 REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

- Terminal 1 is the site of its original 1920's warehouse
- The development will integrate office, retail, and residential space around the central Terminal 1 public market and pier
- New buildings will be constructed to meet Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design Gold standards and will include rigorous efficiency standards for energy, water, and indoor environmental quality
